Proposed Rule Changes for 2008/2009

SECTION B RULES GOVERNING ALL COMPETITIONS "SIGNING ON" REGISTRATION

1(a) All Senior and Junior players must sign a form of the League or Competition, in which they are playing, stating for which club they wish to register. Only players who have attained the age of 15 years on or before 31st August of the playing season may play in men's or women's Senior football. All forms must be signed and in the possession of the Secretary of the League concerned six days before the players take part in any Competition sanctioned or organised by the Association.

1(a) All Senior and Junior players must register with the Jersey FA in order to be eligible to play in the Jersey Combination Football League and Cup Competitions. All Senior and Junior Players must also sign a form of the League or Competition, in which they are playing, stating for which club they wish to register. Only players who have attained the age of 16 years may play in men's or women's senior football. All forms must be signed and in the possession of the Secretary of the League concerned six days before the players take part in any Competition sanctioned or organised by the Association.

D. MANAGEMENT, OFFICERS, DELEGATES, VOTING

D1 The Association shall be managed by a Council which shall consist of:-

- i. An Executive Committee consisting of a President, two Vice-Presidents, an Honorary Treasurer, and a Disciplinary Secretary, who shall have a voice and a vote in all matters before the Council plus a Chief Executive Officer, County Secretary and a Football Development Officer, who shall have a voice but no vote. The President (or Chairman as defined in G1) shall also have a casting vote. Nominations for these offices, except for the Chief Executive Officer, County Secretary and the Football Development Officer who shall be full time employees, shall be forwarded to the County Secretary together with the names of the Proposer and the Seconder not later than fourteen days previous to the date of the Annual General Meeting and these Officers shall be elected thereat. The Proposer and the Seconder must be members of the Council or of an affiliated League or Club appointed to attend the Annual General Meeting. In the absence of nominations for the above-mentioned Offices the Annual General Meeting shall proceed to elect.

D. MANAGEMENT, OFFICERS, DELEGATES, VOTING

D1 The Association shall be managed by a Council which shall consist of:-

- i. An Executive Committee consisting of a President, two Vice-Presidents, an Honorary Treasurer, Disciplinary Secretary and Chief Executive Officer/County Secretary who shall have a voice and a vote in all matters before the Council plus a Football Development Officer, who shall have a voice but no vote. The President (or Chairman as defined in G1) shall also have a casting vote. Nominations for these offices, except for the Chief Executive Officer, County Secretary and the Football Development Officer who shall be full time employees, shall be forwarded to the County Secretary together with the names of the Proposer and the Seconder not later than fourteen days previous to the date of the Annual General

Meeting and these Officers shall be elected thereat. The Proposer and the Seconder must be members of the Council or of an affiliated League or Club appointed to attend the Annual General Meeting. In the absence of nominations for the above-mentioned Offices the Annual General Meeting shall proceed to elect.

Q REFEREES' COMMITTEE

Q1 The Referees' Committee of at least five and not more than seven members shall be elected, at least three of whom shall be either active or retired qualified referees, appointed by the Council.

Q1 The Referees' Committee shall comprise of the Associations appointed Referee Development Officer and at least five and not more than seven members shall be elected, at least three of whom shall be either active or retired qualified referees, appointed by the Council.

REFEREES' COMMITTEE – BYE LAWS

8. An Referee Area Training Team (ATT) has been appointed comprising of the CEO, FDM, RDO, Training Officer, Fitness Co-ordinator and Referee Committee Secretary of both Jersey and Guernsey along with the FA Regional Referee's Development Manager. The purpose of this group is to plan, support and encourage the recruitment and retention of referee's within the Channel Islands. Meetings will be held quarterly with reports being submitted to the Referee's Committee through the Referee's Committee Secretary.
